1. Vide order dated 01.08.2019, the parties were referred to mediation. A Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2019 has been entered into in mediation proceedings, which has been placed on record. Learned counsel for the parties submit that a decree be passed in terms thereof.

2. The Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2019 has been signed by the plaintiff and defendants (through their authorised representative, Mr.Rohit Khanna). The Agreement is also signed by learned counsel for both sides and the mediator.

3. Having regard to the above, there is no impediment to grant of a decree in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2019.

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4. The suit is accordingly decreed in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2019, which will form part of the decree. The decree sheet shall be drawn accordingly.

5. Learned counsel for the defendants undertakes that the communication required to be issued under paragraph 11 (e) of the Settlement Agreement dated 18.11.2019, will be executed within a period of one week from today.

6. Learned counsel for the plaintiff seeks refund of the court fees paid, under Section 16 of the Court Fees Act, 1870. In view of the fact that the parties have entered into a mediated settlement, the conditions prescribed under Section 16 of the Act stand fulfilled and the plaintiff is thus entitled to refund of the court fees. The Registry is directed to issue a certificate accordingly.

7. The suit is disposed of in the above terms.
