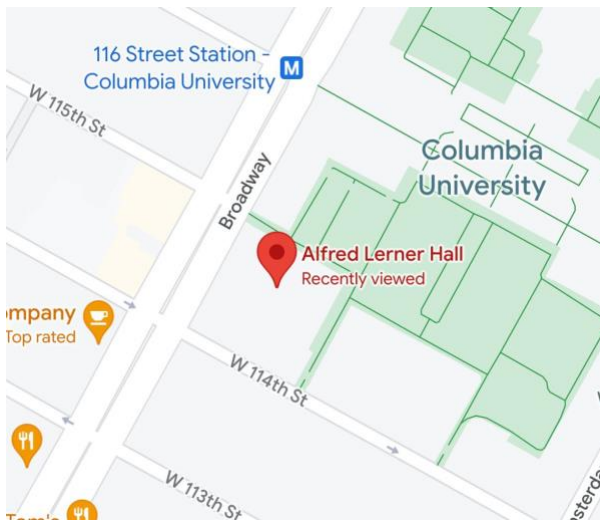

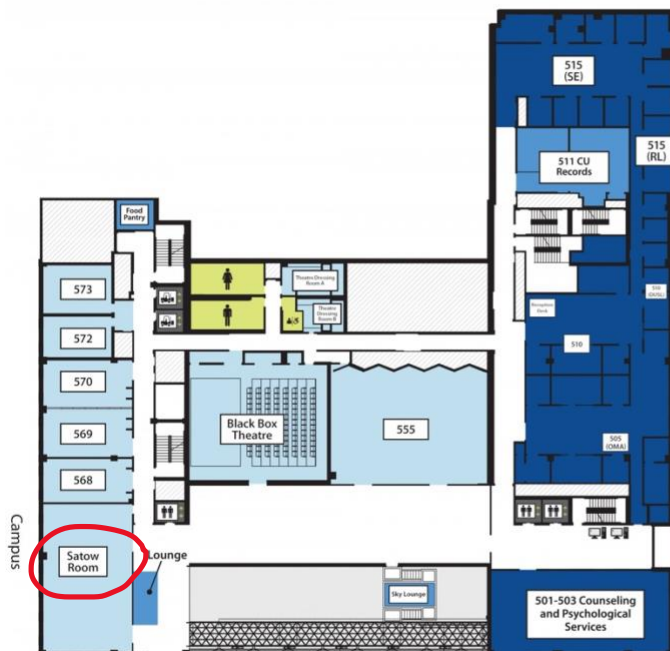
## Directions to Satow Room, Lerner Hall, Columbia University

The Wednesday May 3<sup>rd</sup> morning Side Events (9am-1:30pm ET) will be held in the **Satow Room**, located in Lerner Hall, Columbia University, 2920 Broadway, New York, NY 10027.

⇒ You must enter through the Broadway entrance of Lerner Hall (between 114<sup>th</sup> and 115<sup>th</sup> St.) and then take the elevator to the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor



**MTA Subway:** A ticket will cost \$2.75 per ride. One subway line (the No. 1 local) serves the Columbia neighborhood. The subway station is called Columbia University/116th Street. Please note: if you begin your subway journey on the #2 or #3 express train, be certain to transfer at 96th Street to the #1 train, as the #2 and #3 trains turn away from Manhattan’s Upper West Side before 116th Street. Maps of subway routes are available on the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) website. Fares on subways and local buses are \$2.75 per ride, with free transfers available; riders can purchase a MetroCard at all subway stations or use contactless payment on their phones.
